Today, we received notification that the team member's test returned with a positive result. This team member continues to self-quarantine in their home and will only return to work duties at Orchard Ridge after current CDC "recovery" protocols have been met. Our thoughts are with this team member their family, and we pray for their quick and easy recovery.

Because this team member had direct contact with others prior to the required self-quarantine, those individuals will continue to complete their 14-day self-quarantine, following current guidelines from the Frederick/Winchester Health Department. All of these individuals are free from symptoms and report they are doing well.
