I am excited for our first COVID vaccine clinic happening this Sunday, January 24. Please read below for vaccine clinic updates and information on what to expect during the testing and vaccine clinic. Additionally, attached to this document, you will find a COVID-19 vaccine FAQ sheet prepared by the Path Forward team.

If you have not registered to receive the vaccine and you wish to do so, please contact Lauren Gwinn of myPotential at Home at 540-450-0313. She will register you for the February 14 COVID-19 test and vaccine clinic. If you need to cancel your appointment time, please call Lauren at the number above.

Mostly importantly, if you are feeling ill on Sunday, please do not come to either the testing location or vaccine location and contact Lauren Gwinn at the number above. She will provide additional guidance based on your symptoms.

COVID-19 Testing Location: Garden Room (North Dining Room)

- Please arrive no earlier than five minutes before your appointment time. *Please do not arrive early, as we are limited to the number of people who can be in the testing area.*
- The rapid COVID-19 test will be administered through a nasal swab.
- Expect a 15 minute wait time for the COVID-19 test result.
- Residents with a negative COVID-19 test result will be given a voucher indicating they are COVID-19-free. This voucher must be brought to the vaccine clinic in the Chapel to receive the COVID-19 vaccine.
- Residents with a positive COVID-19 test result will be provided further guidance on isolation requirements, and our team will reschedule the resident for the vaccine clinic on February 14.
- Once results are received, residents are asked to continue with their daily routines, returning to their apartment or cottage.

COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic Location: Chapel

- Wear your mask and short sleeves to your appointment.
- Please arrive no earlier than five minutes before your appointment time. *Please do not arrive early, as we are limited to the number of people who can be in the vaccine area.*
- Please bring the COVID-19-free voucher with you to your vaccine appointment.
- After you receive the vaccine, you will be monitored for 15 minutes.

FAQ regarding the Vaccine

Q: Is there an EpiPen on hand if I have a severe allergic reaction immediately after receiving the vaccine?

A: Yes, Walgreens has confirmed that there will be an EpiPen on hand, and it will be administered immediately if you have a severe reaction.

Q: What should I expect after getting the COVID vaccine?

A: You may have some side effects, which are expected signs that your body is building protection. These side effects may affect your ability to perform daily activities, but they resolve within a few days. Please continue to refer to the CDC's "What to expect after getting a COVID-19 vaccine" that was provided with previous education.
